COLLISION DETAILS:

On November 21st 2008, at 6:40 p.m., a critical injury auto / pedestrian collision occurred in the south alley of 4043 Silver Dollar Avenue, near building 29. Evidence and witness statements indicate a 1997 Chevy Blazer was westbound in the south alley in order to exit onto Wing Street. A five year old male juvenile was southbound between parked vehicles when he entered the path of the Chevy Blazer. The Chevy Blazer was unable to stop and struck the juvenile. The juvenile was transported to UMC Trauma where he was admitted in critical condition. The collision remains under investigation by the LVMPD Accident Investigation Detail.
