COLLISION DETAILS:

On December 13, 2008 at approximately 6:00 p.m., an auto – pedestrian traffic accident occurred on Wynn Road north of Twain Avenue. Evidence at the scene and a witness indicate the pedestrian was attempting to cross Wynn Road outside of a marked crosswalk nor at an intersection. The pedestrian entered the southbound travel lane and was struck by the front of the Toyota Celica. The pedestrian was transported to University Medical Center where he was admitted in critical condition. It appears pedestrian error is the cause of this accident. The accident remains under investigation by the LVMPD Accident Investigation Detail.
